## Privacy Policy

### Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains in detail the types of personal data we may collect about you when you interact with us. It also explains how we will store and handle that data and keep it safe.

We know that there is a lot of information here, but we want you to be fully informed about your rights, and how ASWomen FC uses your data.

We hope the following sections will answer any questions you have but if not, please do get in touch with us.

It's likely that we'll need to update this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify you of any significant changes, but you're welcome to come back and check it whenever you wish.

When you are using the ASWomen website, ASWomen FC is the data controller.

What is ASWomen FC?

Accrington Stanley Women Football Club (ASWomen FC) are a grassroots football club that aim to provide a footballing pathway for ladies and girls that wish to take part, have fun and progress within womens football

Explaining the legal Basis we rely on - The law on data protection sets out a number of different reasons for which a company may collect and process your personal data, including:

Consent

In specific situations, we can collect and process your data with your consent.

For example, when you tick a box to receive email newsletters or for us to contact you reference your child.

When collecting your personal data, we'll always make clear to you which data is necessary in connection with a particular service.

#### Contractual obligations

In certain circumstances, we need your personal data to comply with our contractual obligations. For example, when you place an order with us and make payment using a credit or debit card.

#### Legal compliance

If the law requires us to, we may need to collect and process your data.

For example, we can pass on details of people involved in criminal activity affecting ASWomen FC to law enforcement.

#### Legitimate interest

In specific situations, we require your data to pursue our legitimate interests in a way which might reasonably be expected as part of running our business and which does not materially impact your rights, freedom or interests.

#### When do we collect your personal data?

We collect data about you when you place an order with us or when sign up to our newsletter.

#### What sort of personal data do we collect?

We collect information such as your name, address, email address, phone number. We only collect information relevant to your reason for contacting us. We will not ask for card details if there is no purchase being made. For subs and purchases you will be asked to setup a standing order with your bank or purchase via our payment provider on our website

How and Why, we use your personal data?

We will not share your information with third parties unless required to do so for legal purposes.

How we will make direct contact with you.

We ask our clients/employees for their consent to contact them initially for player registration. You can opt out of any newsletters or items at any time
